<u>Care and cultivation</u> – Autumn activities

Remove aged leaves resulting from late Spring and Summer growth. These can harbour pesky Mealy Bugs. While you are at it check behind/underneath each leaf for any tell-tale signs, as follows:



The extreme weather conditions this Summer have been ideal for Mealy Bug, so have a good look.

If found, treat without delay:

Following are natural and proprietary products that have proven to be effective against Mealy Bug.

- Neem® oil
- Confidor®
- Crown®
- Removal by hand, wipe and crush.
- Isopropyl alcohol/methylated spirits aqueous solution 50% and 1% detergent solution.
- Biological control with Cryptolaemus montrozieri (Lady Bird larvae).

Make sure you closely follow chemical application rates/instructions.

Ensure the bases of the leaves are drenched and the surrounding surface as well as pockets of these pests travelled widely during the hot/dry Summer.

<u>Care and cultivation</u> – Prepare for flowering now.

Clivia umbels develop in the form of an embryonic growth sitting deep in the centre of the plant on the surface of the meristematic tissue. They require a trigger of Potassium to initiate.

If you have not done so – apply Potash (Potassium sulphate) granule at recommended rate [a heaped teaspoon per plant] roughly scratch into the surface. Water.

NB: Potash is usually a coarse granule that will dissolve gradually over an extended period.

Alternatively – Feed your Clivias monthly with soluble Potassium sulphate (follow instructions) monthly from February to April.
